

## Registration Information: State-Tuition DNP programs

- Population Health Nursing-formerly called Community Health Nursing
- Pediatric Clinical Nurse Specialist
- Pediatric Nurse Practitioner-Primary Care
- Pediatric Nurse Practitioner-Acute Care
- Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner

These programs are eligible for use of the UW/Washington State employee tuition waiver benefit.

- To avoid a late fee, register PRIOR to the first day of the quarter: Refer to the [UW Academic Calendar](#). As long as you are registered for at least one course prior to the start of a quarter, for a limited window once a quarter has started, you are able to make changes to your course enrollment without penalties.
- The one exception is UW or Washington State employees who intend to use a tuition waiver benefit. You must wait for the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> day of the quarter to register. In addition, 2 weeks prior to the start of each quarter, you must submit a Tuition Exemption Request Form to the UW Registration Office. - Once you have registered your tuition and fee balance will appear on your MyUW page. Payment of tuition and fees can be made online with a credit card and is typically due by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the quarter (see [UW Academic Calendar](#)).
