

Registration Information:
Fee-Based Advanced Practice Graduate Certificate Programs

Please note: UW PCE programs are not eligible for use of the UW/Washington State employee tuition waiver benefit.

- Refer to registration instructions here: <https://www.degreereg.uw.edu/user-guide/>. We recommend keeping these open while registering.
- Pay special attention to Step 3: Find Your Courses. You need to look up the Schedule Line Numbers (SLN's) for your courses in the Professional and Continuing Education time schedule. Make a note of these PCE SLN's before attempting to register for your courses in MyUW, as you will likely be required to type them in.
- To avoid a late fee, register PRIOR to the first day of the quarter: Refer to the UW Academic Calendar. As long as you are registered for at least one course prior to the start of a quarter, for a limited window once a quarter has started, you are able to make changes to your course enrollment without penalties.
- Once you have registered your tuition and fee balance will appear on your MyUW page. Payment of tuition and fees can be made online with a credit card and is typically due by the end of the 3rd week of the quarter (see UW Academic Calendar).
- If you plan to pay by check or money order OR if you are receiving any sort of funding support, be sure to review Payment Procedures for Fee-Based Degree Students: <https://www.degreereg.uw.edu/payment-procedures/>. For those of you receiving funding support (financial aid, 3rd party payment, veteran benefits) you will find instructions for checking to be sure arrangements for disbursement of the support is in order.
- Fee-based PCE program students are charged an instructional rate per credit hour of enrollment along with mandatory fees. To find the estimated current costs for your program, look at your program Costs page:
 1. Go to the School of Nursing website
 2. Choose Academic Programs at top of page
 3. Select Graduate certificates
 4. Look for your program in the list
 5. Select "Costs"
