A UNIQUE Program

- The VA Puget Sound Health Care System (PSHCS) Primary Care Nurse Practitioner Residency (PC-NPR) program is designed for new providers in primary care to build upon the foundational framework of education in advanced practice. Our 12-month long program uniquely offers leadership, practice inquiry, team based chronic disease management, and interprofessional collaborative workplace learning.
- The Seattle VA PSHCS Center of Education for Interprofessional Collaboration (CoEIPC) is part of a national effort, initiated by the VA Office of Academic Affiliations (OAA), to transform clinical education of primary care providers who deliver patient-centered longitudinal primary care in an interprofessional setting. The VA has been recognized as a leader in interprofessional practice and education.

Mission & Goals

MISSION: To prepare Nurse Practitioners (NPs) as highly effective, competent, and autonomous primary care providers in a team based, interprofessional, collaborative setting to increase access to quality primary care for Veterans.

GOALS:

- **ADVANCED PRACTICE:** Utilize evidence-based practice to care for complex, diverse populations across the adult life span. Clinical continuity will support sustained relationships and shared decision making with patients and families while providing patient centered care.
- **CLINICAL INQUIRY:** Provide clinical training necessary for practice improvement, quality improvement and population management.
- **LEADERSHIP:** Apply leadership strategies that support collaborative practice and team effectiveness.
- **MENTORSHIP:** Offer guided support to transition from novice provider to proficient clinician.
