Job Summary: Under general direction, the GRSA will work to support non-instructional Public Health Nursing research activities related to advancing population health nursing practice.

Roles and Responsibilities of the SA include:

- Work with UW PHN faculty to conduct and synthesize a literature review of studies related to the public health nursing workforce
- Assist in PHN-related manuscript development and grant writing
- Assist PHN faculty in communicating the value of the DNP in PHSL to prospective applicants
